

Privacy policy S.Z.V. Aquifer

S.Z.V. Aquifer values the protection of your personal data. In this Privacy Policy we want to provide clear and transparent information about how we handle personal data.

We do everything we can to guarantee your privacy and therefore we handle personal data with care. S.Z.V. Aquifer complies in all cases with the applicable laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation (AVG). This means that in any case we will:

- Process your personal data in accordance with the purpose for which it was provided, these purposes and type of personal data are described in this Privacy policy;
- Processing of your personal data is limited to only the data that is minimal needed for these purposes;
- Ask for your explicit consent if we need it, for the processing of your personal data;
- Have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the security of your personal data;
- Not pass on personal data to other parties, unless this is necessary for the execution of the purposes for which they were provided;
- Be aware of your rights regarding your personal data, point this out to you and respect them.

As S.Z.V. Aquifer we are responsible for the processing of your personal data. If, after reviewing our Privacy Policy, or in a more general sense, you have questions about this or wish to contact us, you can do so via the contact details at the bottom of this document.

Processing of members' personal data

Personal data are processed by S.Z.V. Aquifer for the following purpose(s):

- Administrative purposes;
- Inform members (e.g., newsletters).

The basis for this personal data is:

- Subscription to S.Z.V. Aquifer;

For the above purpose(s), S.Z.V. Aquifer may request the following personal data from you:

- Language;
- First name;
- Last name;
- Initials;
- Saluting;
- Date of birth;
- Street name;
- House number;
- Postal code;
- City name;
- Telephone number;
- E-mail address;
- Bank account number;

- Date of registration form;
- Date of deregistration;
- Possibly. bib number;
- Possibly. Other swimming association;
- Student card number;
- Sports card number.

Your personal data will be stored by S.Z.V. Aquifer for the above-mentioned processing(s) for the period:

- During the term of the membership at S.Z.V. Aquifer and thereafter only in the administration.

Provision to third parties

We can provide the data you give us to third parties. The third parties are:

- The sister associations in the Netherlands, when registering for an activity or competition;
- S.W.U. Thymos, for the (financial) administration;
- Sportlink, for the administration of the KNZB.

We will not provide the information you provide to other parties, unless this is legally required and permitted or you give us written permission for this.

Within the EU

We do not provide personal data to parties located outside the EU.

Retention period

S.Z.V. Aquifer does not store personal data longer than necessary for the purpose for which it was provided or is required by law.

Security

We have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against unlawful processing, for example, we have taken the following measures;

- We have a username and password policy on all our systems;
- We make back-ups of the personal data in order to be able to restore it in the event of physical or technical incidents.

Rights regarding your data

You have the right to inspect, rectify or delete the personal data that we have received from you. You can also object to the processing of your personal data (or part of it) by us or third parties. You also have the right to have the data provided by you transferred by us to yourself or on your behalf directly to another party. We may ask you to identify yourself before we can respond to the aforementioned requests.

If we are allowed to process your personal data on the basis of a permission given by you, you always have the right to withdraw this consent.

Complaints

If you have a complaint about the processing of your personal data, we ask you to contact us directly. If we cannot find a way together with you, we will of course find this very annoying. You always have the right to file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority (AVG), which is the supervisory authority in the field of privacy protection.
